

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 254787

Adopted on AUG 10 1981

WHEREAS, Chapter VIII, Article 6, Division 20, of the San Diego Municipal Code provides procedures for the establishment of residential permit parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the University Hospital area have petitioned the City to evaluate their area for residential permit parking; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has conducted a study of the parking problems in the area of University Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the Manager indicated that legal on-street vehicle parking places were almost totally occupied during the period from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the Manager indicated that approximately 86% of the vehicles parked on the streets in the proposed study area were not registered at addresses within the study area; and

WHEREAS, the survey conducted by the Manager indicated that the number of registered vehicles within the area exceeds the total number of off-street spaces available by a ratio of 1.3 to 1.0; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's survey has indicated that a residential permit parking system would alleviate the current parking problems if non-residents were not permitted to park within the studied residential area; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 1981, the City Manager conducted a public hearing in the proposed residential permit parking area to receive information regarding the desire and need of the residents for residential permit parking; and

WHEREAS, in the petition requesting the implementation of a residential permit parking system and in the hearing conducted as a result of its submission, the necessity for a parking prohibition was discussed; and

WHEREAS, the notice of the hearing provided by the City Manager did not exclude the potential implementation of a residential parking area prohibition; and

WHEREAS, based upon the City Manager's survey and the residents' petition, a parking prohibition would be effective; and

WHEREAS, the testimony of the area residents at the public hearing indicated overwhelming support for parking prohibition as the appropriate means of reducing noise, air pollution and neighborhood congestion created by the excessive number of commuter vehicles using the streets of their neighborhood; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the area delineated on the document attached as Attachment I to this resolution be and it is hereby declared to be Residential Permit Parking Area A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that resident vehicles or transient vehicles possessing valid permits shall be permitted to park in Residential Permit Parking Area A from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that vehicles not possessing valid permits shall be prohibited from parking in Residential Permit Parking Area A during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the annual fee for residential parking permits shall be ten dollars (\$10.00), and the fee for temporary residential parking permits shall be two dollars (\$2.00).


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that on or after the effective date of this resolution the City Manager is directed to erect appropriate signs in

Residential Permit Parking Area A indicating prominently thereon the parking prohibition, the period of time of its application and the conditions of exemption therefrom.

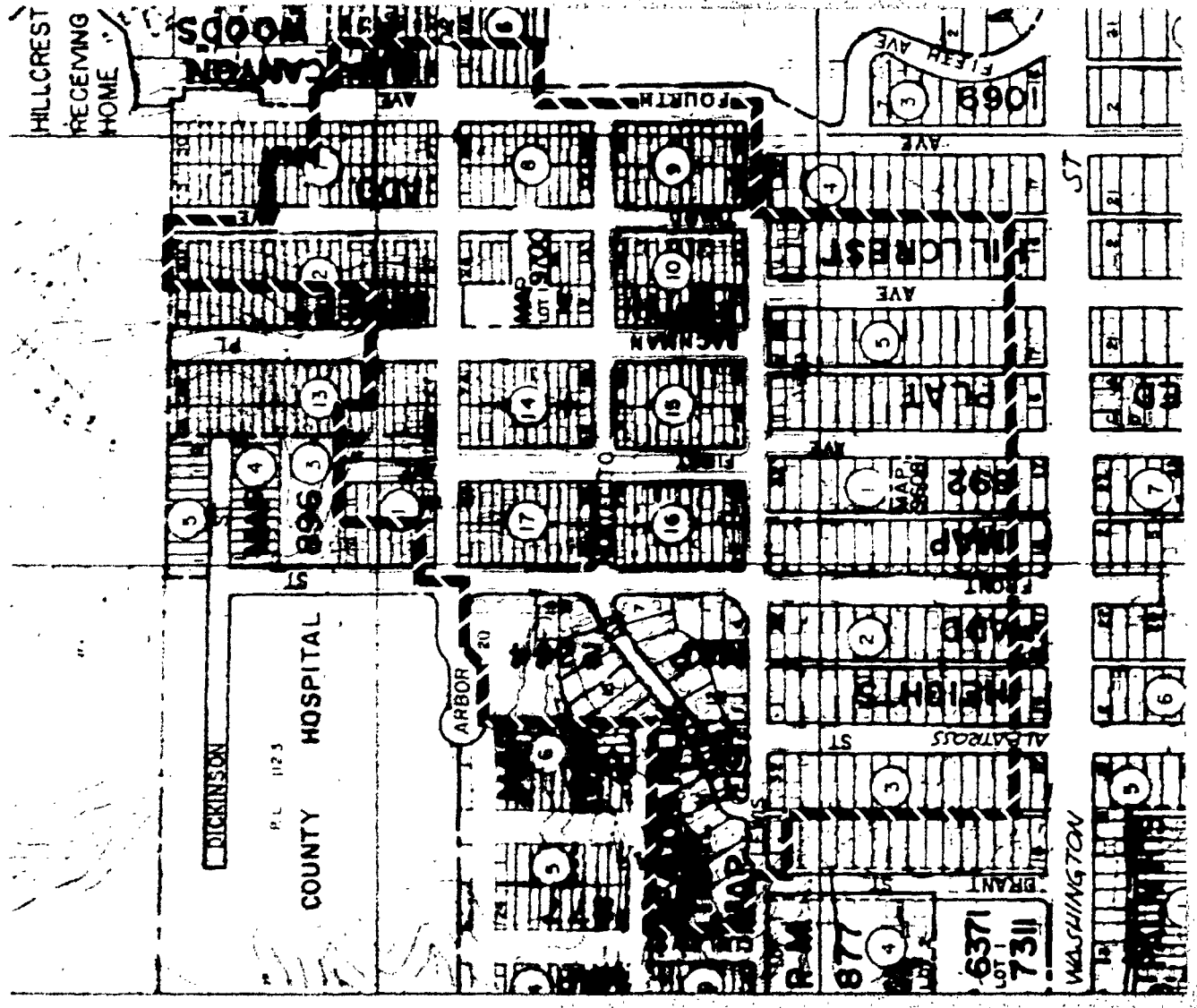
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anniversary month for Residential Permit Parking Area A shall be October.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become effective on the same day as Ordinance No. 0- 15574, amending Chapter VIII, Article 6, Division 20, concerning the residential permit parking program, becomes effective.
