WHEREAS, it is desirable to reduce the nation's energy consumption and dependence on foreign oil and extended Daylight Savings Time would provide a no-cost method for the nation to reduce its electricity consumption by an estimated one percent (1%) for the months of March and April; and

WHEREAS, a Federal study has shown consistently less violent crime for periods of Daylight Savings Time when compared to similar periods of standard time; and

WHEREAS, most traffic fatalities occur at night, and extended Daylight Savings Time would provide a longer lighted period for drivers returning home from work, thus increasing traffic safety; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Council strongly supports Federal legislation to extend the length of Daylight Savings Time by two months.
