

RESOLUTION NO. R-254907 (R-82-302) Rev.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego recognizes the social and economic value to this region being made by national defense efforts, and particularly by the United States Navy, and the City strongly supports these ongoing activities; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is committed to assist and support efforts by the U.S. Navy to provide adequate and affordable housing for military personnel and their families; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Navy had recently proposed a housing project for the Mission Trails Regional Park/Tierrasanta area which project, as planned, would ultimately include at least 3,500 units; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of The City of San Diego has previously expressed its opposition to the development of an additional Navy Housing Project in the Mission Trail Regional Park/Tierrasanta area; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Navy has cooperated with the San Diego community in identifying alternative locations for its proposed housing construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego believes that the Navy's selected alternatives show a sensitivity to the concerns of the community as well as the needs of the military families who need the additional housing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego concurs with the Navy's intent to:

1. Build the first family increment of some 290 units at NAS Miramar and Carroll Canyon, and
2. Work with the City Planning Department to attempt to locate alternatives to building additional increments in the Tierrasanta area, with the alternatives to be decided upon by December 1982.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that based upon the issues raised in City Council Resolution No. R-254164, the Council continues to oppose the designation of the Mission Trails Regional Park/ Tierrasanta area as the preferred site for such housing.
