WHEREAS, this resolution required removal of streets, sidewalks, and grass in preparation for paving with soild-cement; and

WHEREAS, the funds allocated to this restoration have been depleted; and WHEREAS, the Park has been left with unpaved walkways and plywood and dirt paths; and

WHEREAS, as a result thereof, the visitor traffic to the park is down ten percent (10%) at what otherwise would be its peak tourist season; NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, wholeheartedly supports the California State Park and Recreation Department's intention to use Minor Capital Improvement funds to complete the restoration of Old Town San Diego State Historic Park in 1981.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Intergovernmental Relations be and he is hereby directed to send a copy of this document to Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr., to State Park and Recreation Director Dangermond, and to the San Diego Legislative Delegation.
