WHEREAS, the primary source of street financing for the City and County of San Diego is the State gasoline tax; and

WHEREAS, the last gas tax increase occurred in 1963; and WHEREAS, during the period between 1963 and 1981 the revenues derived from the gas tax has been inadequate to sustain the City's street construction and maintenance program; and

whereas, Senate Bill 215 which would provide the San Diego region with approximately \$47.2 million of new gas tax funds over a five-year period beginning in fiscal year 1982; and

WHEREAS, the City would receive approximately \$17 million of this amount; and

WHEREAS, the City would also receive additional revenues from the Diesel Fuel Tax and the 6% sales tax on gasoline; and

WHEREAS, the combination of these revenues are essential to the City's street construction and maintenance program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the San Diego Board of Supervisors is respectfully requested to adopt, not later than November 15, 1981, the resolution declaring the need for the new revenues as called for in Section 41 of Senate Bill 215 so that the bill will become law.
