RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NUMBER R- **255173**

Adopted on **OCT 12 1981**

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE THE ALLEY ADJACENT TO LOTS A THROUGH F IN BLOCK 19 OF LAS ALTURAS NO. 5, MAP NO. 2053, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of a portion of the street hereinafter mentioned; and in connection therewith require the reservation of certain easements for the alley adjacent to Lots A through F in Block 19 of Las Alturas No. 5, Map No. 2053 in the area covered by such street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of the alley adjacent to Lots A through F in Block 19 of Las Alturas No. 5, Map No. 2053, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15367-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **255173**.

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law."

The Council hereby fixes 2:00 p.m. **NOV 16 1981** in the Council Chambers on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
