WHEREAS, the SANDAG Board of Directors appointed an Advisory Committee to examine the roles of public agencies in support of economic development and to make recommendations to increase the effectiveness of support provided; and

WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee has completed that task and has issued a report for Regional Economic Development, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. R-255193; and

WHEREAS, that report has been examined and analyzed by staff and recommendations submitted in respect thereto to support the conclusions and recommendations with certain specified qualifications as hereinafter set forth; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City's representative to SANDAG be and is hereby directed to present the position of The City of San Diego at SANDAG as supporting inclusion of the Reports of the SANDAG Economic Development Strategy Advisory Committee as an element of the SANDAG Regional Comprehensive Plan, predicated upon conditionally supporting the recommendations included in the Committee's Report as follows:

- a. Conditionally supporting Recommendations 1, 3, 4 and 6 as qualified in the City Manager's Report No. 81-371, dated September 16, 1981, entitled "SANDAG Regional Economic Development Strategy Advisory Committee Report."
- b. That the City's position on Recommendation 2, <u>Use of Public Resources</u>, be that while public agencies should actively review their level of support for economic development, especially in distressed areas as exemplified by the efforts of the Southeast Economic Development Corporation in Southeast San Diego, public agencies should be free to decide between targeting specific resources for economic development or allocating resources within the context

of existing budget policies and procedures.

c. That the City's position on Recommendation 5, <u>Clearinghouse</u>, be that it should first be clarified as to the unfulfilled needs the clearinghouse would serve, to whom its services would be targeted, what institutional arrangements would occur and how it would be financed and, further, that should such clearinghouse function be determined as desirable, that the San Diego Economic Development Corporation be considered as the clearinghouse agency.
