

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 255251

Adopted on OCT 26 1981

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the bids of 1. UNIVERSITY FORD, 2. CARL BURGER'S DODGE WORLD and 3. PEARSON FORD are hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contracts for the purchase of LIGHT DUTY VEHICLES as follows:


1. UNIVERSITY FORD for Item 1, two (2) compact sedans (Ford Escort) at a cost of \$5,936.62 each, for a total cost of \$11,873.24; terms net 20 days, plus sales tax.

2. CARL BURGER'S DODGE WORLD for Item 2, one (1) intermediate sedan (Dodge Diplomat) at a cost of \$7,845.28; Item 5, two (2) each one half ton pickup (4 x 4) (Dodge Sweptline W150-115" wheelbase) at a cost of \$8,800.25 each; Item 7, three (3) each three quarter ton pickup (Dodge Sweptline D-250 131" wheelbase) at a cost of \$7,922.21 each; Item 8, one (1) each three quarter ton pickup (4 x 4) (Dodge Sweptline D-250 131" wheelbase) at a cost of \$9,227.26; Item 9, one (1) each one ton cab and chassis (Dodge D-350 135" wheelbase) at a cost of \$8,293.27; Item 10, one (1) each one ton cab and chassis with PTO (Dodge D-350 135" wheelbase) at a cost of \$8,322.46; Item 11, three (3) each 9,000 lb. GVW van (Dodge B-350 maxi-van) at a cost of \$9,170.66 each, for a total cost of \$120,198.28; terms net 10 days, plus sales tax.

3. PEARSON FORD for Item 3, eighty-seven (87) compact pickups (Ford Courier) at a cost of \$6,229.00 each; Item 4, fifteen (15) compact pickups long bed (Ford Courier) at a cost of \$6,367.00 each, for a total cost of \$637,428.00; terms net 15 days, plus sales tax.
