That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Michael D. Shea	Fire	\$ 130	Mr. Shea is a Fire Fighter. He suggested that a service apparatus be removed from service and its equipment be installed on a utility vehicle. This is expected to save \$1,277 in the first year in costs for maintenance and material.
Joan M. Dolan	Planning	\$ 125	Ms. Dolan is an Intermediate Stenographer. One year ago she earned a partial award of \$120 for her suggestion to discontinue mailing permits via Certified Mail. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$811. This is the remainder of her award.
Robert J. Boisvert	Police	\$ 100	Mr. Boisvert is a Police Officer. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$50 for his suggestion to distribute only one copy of the theft related misdemeanor reports to investigations division. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,506. This is the remainder of his award.
Robert L. Spangler	Fire	\$ 100	Mr. Spangler is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that ladder belts be replaced with safer and less expensive equipment. This is expected to save \$4,039 in the first year in equipment costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Catherine M. Jagers	General Services	\$ 90	Ms. Jagers is an Intermediate Typist in the Equipment Division. She suggested that vehicle files be converted so that they can be filed in a standard file rather than a lateral file. This is expected to save \$594 in the first year in labor costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
