That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Tony C. Zepeda	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Zepeda is a Carpenter in the Buildings Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$60 for his suggestion to save the pins from old hinges. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$270. This is the remainder of his award.
John M. Fix	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Fix is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He suggested that a voltmeter and switch be installed on trailers equipped with electric brakes. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Thomas G. Simonds	Police	\$ 20	Mr. Simonds is a Police Officer. He suggested that signs be posted to indicate the location of the fire extinguishers. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Ronald E. Charlton	Park & Recreation	\$ 20	Mr. Charlton is a Grounds Maintenance Worker in the Coastal Division. He suggested that dumpsters on Sunset Cliffs Boulevard be replaced with trash barrels. This is expected to save \$1,362 in the first year in contract costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Charles B. Einolander	General Services	\$ 15	Mr. Einolander is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$85 for his suggestion to relocate the auxiliary engine sprinkler system water pump on the Mobil sweepers. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$335. This is the remainder of his award.
