WHEREAS, ANTHONY R. CORTES appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in approving a modification of Tentative Subdivision Map TM-02-102-0 (Sara Lynn Subdivision) which proposes a 2-unit, 2-lot subdivision of portions of Lots 1 and 2 of the east 1/2 of Pueblo Lot 1215, Map 690 (approximately 2.3 acres), located on the west side of Angelucci Street at Stalmer Street, in the Clairemont Mesa Community Plan area; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1981, the Planning Commission voted 6 to 0 to deny the appeal and approve the tentative map with modifications, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on October 6, 1981; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 1981, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, ANTHONY R. CORTES, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on October 27, 1981, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

whereas, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council adopts findings as follows:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and Clairemont Community Plan which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are consistent with the General Plan, Clairemont Mesa Community Plan, and R-2A Zoning/Development Regulations.
- 3. The site is physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 81-04-21 ND.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems inasmuch as the map is consistent with R-2A zoning and conforms with City development regulations.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.
- 8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps, and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of ANTHONY R.

R-255279 00498 CORTES is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission is upheld, and said Tentative Subdivision Map TM-02-102-0 is hereby granted.
