
RESOLUTION No. R-255388 (R-82-672)

2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$58,225.80 within the Sewer Revenue Fund 41506 from the Unallocated Reserve (70697) to the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations Program (70225).
