WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Rosalie A. Gonzalez William L. Colding	General Services	\$1,355	Ms. Gonzalez and Mr. Colding are Sanitation Inspectors in the Streets Division. One year ago they earned a partial award of \$100 for their suggestion to initiate a system of mini neighborhood clean-ups to replace 80% of all clean-ups. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$4,848. This is the remainder of their award.
Inge Davidson	Risk Management	\$1,000	Ms. Davidson was a Claims Representative at the time she submitted her suggestion to hire a bill auditor to audit Workers' Compensation medical bills. This is expected to save \$128,812 in medical expenses. This is a full award.
Russell W. Brand	General Services	\$ 860	Mr. Brand is a Welder Apprentice in the Equipment Division. He suggested that ejector blades on Leach Packers be reinforced to prevent more extensive damage. This is expected to save \$5,726 in the first year in labor and material costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Steven Gates Kenneth A. Martinosky	General Services	\$ 725	Mr. Gates and Mr. Martinosky are Equipment Mechanics in the Equipment Division. They suggested the pressure regulator valves on the Dempster packers be remounted. This is expected to save \$4,843 in the first year in labor and material costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
