

RESOLUTION NO. R-255407Adopted on NOV 24 1981

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Edna Gonzales	Police	\$ 185	Ms. Gonzales is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that the processing of the blood alcohol log be simplified. This is expected to save \$614 in the first year in labor costs.
Eduardo M. Castillo	General Services	\$ 180	Mr. Castillo is an Electrician in the Communications and Electrical Division. He suggested that electronic programable time clocks be used to control park lighting. This is expected to save \$596 in the first year in labor, equipment and material costs.
Cathy L. Koivisto	Planning	\$ 175	Ms. Koivisto is a Senior Zoning Representative in the Zoning Division. He suggested that the City charge a fee for processing Garage Conversion Agreements. This is expected to result in an increase in revenue of \$1,170 in the first year. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Iris E. Price	Personnel	\$ 165	Ms. Price is an Intermediate Clerk. She suggested that the procedures for accepting job applications be revised. This is expected to save \$480 in the first year in labor costs.
Jonathan T. Harker	Building Inspection	\$ 130	Mr. Harker was an Intermediate Typist at the time he submitted his suggestion. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$345 for his suggestion to revise the method of releasing gas and electric meters to San Diego Gas and Electric Company. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,579. This is the remainder of his award.
