

RESOLUTION NO. R 255408

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Paul B. Kennedy	Risk Management	\$ 125	Mr. Kennedy is a Claims Representative II. He suggested that the department adopt a policy of adjusting prescription bills paid through Workers' Compensation. This is expected to save \$817 in the first year in costs for employee prescription expenses. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Rolando B. Pritchard	Police	\$ 100	Mr. Pritchard is a Field Representative. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$20 for his suggestion to implement a system for the return of lost or abandoned barricades and pylons. While savings were difficult to calculate, the suggestion resulted in the return of almost 300 lost barricades to City Shops. This is the remainder of his award.
Kenneth B. Keller	General Services	\$ 100	Mr. Keller is an Electrician in the Buildings Division. He suggested that toggle switches be installed on the motors at Sewer Pump Station #64. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Jeffrey L. Frankhouser	General Services	\$ 50	Mr. Frankhouser is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He suggested that a different type fuel filter be installed on the City's newer Ford trucks. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Joe A. Pirronello	Fire	\$ 50	Mr. Pirronello is a Fire Captain. He suggested that an air chisel be used to repair fire hoses. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
