Terrance L. O'Rourke	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. O'Rourke is a Fire Captain. He suggested that racks for drying salvage covers be installed at Fire Station #10. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Frank White	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. White is a Senior Motive Service Technician in the Equipment Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of a Certificate of Merit for his suggestion to use "Royal Seal" tires on the pickup trucks at City landfills. Although no savings were realized, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
H. Duane Dreyer	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Dreyer is a Sanitation Driver in the Solid Waste Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of a Certificate of Merit for his suggestion to change the traffic flow at Chollas Operations Station. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement. This is the remainder of his award.
Ken Anderson	Police	\$ 20	Mr. Anderson is a Police Sergeant. One year ago he earned a partial award of a Certificate of Merit for his suggestion to eliminate the use of the Injury and Sick Transportation Form by the Police Department. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement. This is the remainder of his award.
Paul Berryman	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. Berryman is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that disposable obstetrical kits be included in the Fire Department's first aid equipment. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
