RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 255565

WHEREAS, KEITH and BARBARA McWILLIAMS appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in failing to approve Preliminary Parcel Map PM-02-054-0 which proposes a two-lot parcel of Parcel 2, Parcel Map PM-10858, located at the end of Corral Way, south of Cottontail Lane in the R-1-10 Zone and within the boundaries of the La Jolla Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 1981, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego voted 7 to 0 to deny the preliminary parcel map, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on October 23, 1981; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1981, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, KEITH and BARBARA McWILLIAMS appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on December 15, 1981, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 102.0308, to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the

limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council adopts the findings of the Planning Commission as follows:

- 1. The proposed map is not consistent with the General Plan and La Jolla Community Plan which designate the property for residential use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are not consistent with the General Plan, La Jolla Community Plan, R-1-10 Zoning/Development Regulations and State Map Act Section 66473.1 because of limited access to one parcel.
- 3. The site is not physically suitable for residential development because of parking problems and the subdivision not being compatible with the neighborhood.
- 4. The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development.
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 81-02-29 N.D.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems, however, the map is not consistent with R-1-10 zoning and does not conform with City development regulations.

- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.
- 8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of KEITH and EARBARA McWILLIAMS is denied, the decision of the Planning Commission is upheld, and said Preliminary Parcel Map PM-02-054-0 is hereby denied.
