AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-15552 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-15552-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT, LITIGATION DIVISION (04540) ONE (1) LITIGATION INVESTIGATOR POSITION AND ONE (1) INTERMEDIATE STENOGRAPHER POSITION; TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$23,904 WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND 100 FROM UNALLOCATED RESERVE (605) TO THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT (045) FOR PERSONNEL AND RELATED NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, the litigation caseload of the City Attorney's Litigation Division has increased by 216 cases during the past fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Council had authorized two additional deputy positions last year in view of that large increase in caseload; and

WHEREAS, tort cases must be thoroughly investigated to prepare an adequate defense for the City; and

WHEREAS, the litigation division is currently understaffed by two investigators according to standard attorney/investigator ratios and, as a result, investigation services are performed on a crisis basis rather than during the normal course of case development; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed prudent and in the best interest of the City at this time to provide minimal additional staff to

support the litigation defense effort; NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as
follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-15552 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 00-15552-1, as amended and adopted therein, by adding to the personnel authorization of the City Attorney's Department, Litigation Division (04540) one (1) Litigation Investigator position and one (1) Intermediate Stenographer position.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer within the General Fund 100, the sum of \$23,904 from the Unallocated Reserve (605) to the City Attorney's Department (045) for the sole and exclusive purpose of defraying personnel and related non-personnel expenses.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.


