AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-15552 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-15552-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY MANAGER'S DEPARTMENT (040), ONE (1) POLICE COMMANDER POSITION; EXEMPTING SAID POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Manager has requested a Police Commander's position to be added to his personnel allocation to serve on an interim basis as the City's Labor Relations Administrator; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that
"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for
formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"
may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon
first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil
Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed this request on February 4, 1982, and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropria-

tion ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-15552 (New Series), entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. 00-15552-1, as adopted and amended therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of Department 040, City Manager, one (1) Police Commander position, to serve on an interim basis as the City of San Diego's Labor Relations Administrator.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City
Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably
by the Civil Service Commission on February 4, 1982, the Police
Commander position is hereby exempted from the Classified
Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The
City of San Diego.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rate 07.7 and 07.8 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category, Classification Range C, identified as Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 0-15552 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
