BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:



PARCEL 6
(Eastgate Mall Neighborhood Park)

All that portion of Parcel 2 of Parcel Map No. 4967, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof filed in the Office of the San Diego County Recorder, August 3, 1976, being a division of a portion of Lot 2 of Collegiate Park, according to Map thereof No. 5006, filed in said County Recorder's Office, July 3, 1962, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most Southwesterly corner of said Parcel 2 of Parcel Map No. 4967; thence North 00°20'00" East, 280.00 feet; thence North 50°06'14" West, 259.43 feet; thence North 00°20'00" East, 51.18 feet to the beginning of a 40.00-foot radius curve, concave Southeasterly, a radial to said point bears North 89°40'00" West; thence Northeasterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 90°03'00", an arc length of 62.87 feet; thence South 89°37'00" East, 277.38 feet to the beginning of a 279.00-foot radius curve, concave Northerly, a radial to said point bears South 00°23'00" West; thence Easterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 15°59'03", an arc length of 77.83 feet; thence North 74°23'57" East, 195.31 feet; thence South 15°36'03" East, 226.00 feet; thence South 60°36'03" East, 161.22 feet; thence North 74°23'57" East, 250.00 feet; thence South 15°36'03" East, 75.87 feet; thence North 74°23'57" East, 147.90 feet; thence South 00°21'20" West, 239.29 feet (Record: 214.15 feet to the beginning of a 125.00-foot radius curve, concave Westerly, a radial to said point bears South 89°38'40" East; thence Southerly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 10°15'47", an arc length of 22.39 feet) to the beginning of a 125.00-foot radius curve, concave Northwesterly, a radial to said point bears South 79°22'53" East; thence Southwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 79°46'05, an arc length of 174.03 feet; thence North 89°36'48" West, 1,025.28 feet returning to the Point of Beginning.
