AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING PORTIONS OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF LOT 5 OF HORTON'S PURCHASE IN THE EX-MISSION LANDS OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That portions of the Northwest Quarter of Lot 5 of Horton's Purchase in the Ex-Mission Lands of San Diego, which are more particularly described in Attachment A hereto which is by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the San Diego County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

EXHIBIT A
PARCEL 9
(Hollywood Neighborhood Park)

- A. The Easterly 250.00 feet of that part of the Northwest Quarter of Lot 5 of Horton's Purchase in the Ex-Mission Lands of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 283, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, March 9, 1878, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the East line of said Northwest Quarter, distant thereon North 01°19'13" East, 150.89 feet from the Southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter; thence along the following numbered courses: (1) leaving said East line North 59°25'48" West, 248.54 feet; (2) North 35°50'27" West, 325.70 feet; (3) North 67°24'31" West, 265.35 feet to the West line of said Northwest Quarter; (4) along said West line North 01°24'02" East, 25.50 feet to the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of said Lot 5; (5) leaving said Northwest corner and along the North line of said Northwest Quarter, South 89°12'54" East, 660.86 feet to the East line of said Northwest Quarter; (6) along said East line South 01°19'13" West, 508.95 feet returning to the Point of Beginning.

- B. All that portion of said Northwest Quarter of Lot 5 of Horton's Purchase in the Ex-Mission Lands of San Diego, according to Map thereof No. 283, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, March 9, 1878, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the East line of said Northwest Quarter, distant thereon North 01°19'13" East, 150.89 feet from the Southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter; thence leaving said East line North 59°25'48" West along the Northeasterly line of Interstate 805, 248.54 feet to an angle point therein; thence continuing along the Northeasterly line of said Interstate 805, North 35°50'27" West, 54.88 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, being also a point in the Westerly line of that certain parcel of land conveyed to the City of San Diego by Deed dated March 19, 1973, and recorded September 11, 1973, File/Page 73-254362 of Official Records of said San Diego County Recorder; thence along said Westerly line North 01°19'13" East, 341.44 feet to a point in the Northerly line of said Northwest Quarter; thence along said Northerly line North 89°12'54" West, 18.00 feet; thence leaving said Northerly line South 03°33'00" West, 92.00 feet; thence South 08°48'00" West, 60.00 feet; thence South 29°19'50" West, 100.56 feet to a point in said Northeasterly line of Interstate 805; thence along said Northeasterly line South 35°50'27" East, 126.83 feet returning to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
