BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of the unnumbered tract of land, known as Neptunia Rupes, in First Addition to South La Jolla, together with a portion of the unnamed and unnumbered tract of land in the subdivision of South La Jolla, which are more particularly described in Attachment A hereto which is by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the San Diego County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

(Windansea Shoreline Park)

- 1. All that portion of the unnumbered tract of land, known as Neptunia Rupes, in First Addition to South La Jolla, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 891, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, March 3, 1903, more particularly described in Parcels A, B, and C as follows:
 - A. Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 7 of Fern Glen Colony, according to Map thereof No. 2347, filed in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, September 3, 1946; thence along the Westerly boundary of said Fern Glen Colony, North 36°10'30" West, 28.48 feet; thence North 13°05'00" West, 41.12 feet; thence North 47°31'30" East, 64.15 feet; thence North 37°04'30" East, 23.15 feet; thence North 22°34'10" East, 31.06 feet; thence leaving said Westerly boundary North 83°06'45" West to the Mean High Tide Line of the Pacific Ocean, as shown on the San Diego City Engineering Department Drawing No. 4720-L; thence Southerly along said Mean High Tide Line to its intersection with the Westerly prolongation of the Southerly line of said Lot 7, Fern Glen Colony; thence along said prolongation South 78°03'10" East returning to the Point of Beginning.


