AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7, DIVISION 29, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 27.2941, RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS TO BALLOT MEASURES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 29, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 27.2941 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2941 CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS--LIMITATIONS

- [(a) No change.]
- (b) Extensions of credit for a period of more than thirty (30) days are prohibited. Extensions of credit of more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) are prohibited. Provided, however, a candidate may personally borrow an unlimited amount and such funds shall be considered as a contribution by the candidate himself; provided, further, that such transaction is fully disclosed and documented in accordance with applicable law.
- (c) The terms of this section are applicable to any contributions made to a candidate or committee hereunder, whether used by such candidate or committee to finance a current campaign, to pay deficits incurred in prior campaigns, or otherwise.
- (d) If any person is found guilty of violating the terms of this section, the amount of funds received

constituting such violation shall be paid by the candidate or committee treasurer who received such funds to the City.

Treasurer for deposit in the General Fund of the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Provided, however, a candidate may personally borrow an unlimited amount and such funds shall be considered as a contribution by the condidate himself; provided, further, that such transaction is fully disclosed and documented in accordance with applicable law.

(c) The terms of this section are applicable to any contributions made to a candidate or committee hereunder, whether used by such candidate or committee to finance a current campaign, to pay deficits incurred in prior campaigns, or otherwise.

(d) If any person is found guilty of violating the terms of this section, the amount of funds received constituting such violation shell be paid by the candidate or committee treasurer who received such funds to the City Treasurer for deposit in the General Fund of the City.
