AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON NOVEMBER 2, 1982, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ONE PROPOSITION RELATING TO AN INITIATIVE MEASURE RELATING TO CRITERIA FOR A PARAMEDIC TRANSPORT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has certified to the City Council that an initiative petition to adopt an ordinance relating to criteria for a Paramedic Transport System has a sufficient number of signatures to qualify the initiative for the ballot under Section 23 of the City Charter and Section 27.2503 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to submit the aforementioned initiative to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego at a special municipal election to be held in the City on November 2, 1982; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on JUL 26 1982, the City Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R-256877 requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego to order the consolidation of a special municipal election to be held on November 2, 1982, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, California, as follows:

Section 1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of San Diego, California, on November 2, 1982, and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 16, 17 and 23 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, the Council of The City of San Diego, being the legislative body thereof, hereby submits to the qualified voters of the City at such special municipal election the following proposition:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CRITERIA
FOR A PARAMEDIC TRANSPORT SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the people of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. In order to maintain an adequate level of paramedic services, the City will adopt a Paramedic Transport System meeting the following criteria:

A. All Paramedics will be assigned to Paramedic Transport ambulances meeting the requirements for Paramedic ambulances set by State law. Paramedics will respond to all medical emergencies in these Paramedic ambulances. Paramedics will transport all patients requiring Paramedic care to an emergency medical facility in these Paramedic ambulances, in accordance with State law and San Diego County Paramedic protocols.

B. The system adopted may use public resources

only, a combination of public and private resources or private resources only.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its adoption by the electors.

Section 2. The proposition shall be presented and printed upon the ballot and submitted to the voters in the manner and form set out in Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 3. The polls for this special municipal election shall be open at 7 a.m. (local time) on November 2, 1982, and remain open continuously until 8 p.m. (local time) on the same day at which time the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14301 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 4. Since this election is being consolidated with the statewide general election and since the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass returns of this election, and since only one form of ballot is authorized, the method of voting upon the proposition shall be as provided in the Elections Code of the State of California; and, on the ballots to be used at this special municipal election, in addition to any other matters required by law, there shall be printed substantially the following:

Section 5. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "YES," shall be counted in favor of the adoption of the proposition. An appropriate mark placed in the voting square after the word "NO," in the manner hereinbefore provided shall be counted against the adoption of the proposition.

Section 6. The special municipal election called for November 2, 1982, in the City of San Diego is hereby ordered consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date. Within the City of San Diego the precincts, polling places and officers of the election for the special municipal election shall be the same as those provided for in the statewide general election.

Section 7. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and these elections shall be held in all

respects as if there were only one election, and within the City only one form of ballot shall be used. The Board of Supervisors shall certify the results of the canvass of the returns of this special municipal election to the Council of The City of San Diego which shall then declare the results of the election.

Section 8. The proposition submitted by this ordinance shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

Section 9. Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, the special municipal election shall be conducted as provided by law for other municipal elections of the City.

Section 10. The City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper. No other notice of the election need be given.

Section 11. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter, this ordinance relating to elections shall take effect on

JUL 26 1982, being the day of its introduction and passage.
