AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 10 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY
AMENDING SECTION 22.1019 ENTITLED, "INDUSTRIAL
LEAVE."

WHEREAS, the City Council instructed its Management Team,
in meeting and conferring with designated employee
representatives, to propose an amendment to the City's
Industrial Leave Program; and

WHEREAS, agreements were reached with each of the
respective organizations which provide that the Industrial Leave
benefit shall be gross pay less normal state and federal tax
withholdings; and

WHEREAS, such agreements were accepted by the City Council
on May 10, 1982 pursuant to Resolution No. R-256365; NOW,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 10, of the
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by


