AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-15750 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1982-83," BY EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF INVESTMENT OFFICER FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT C TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE CLASSIFICATION OF INVESTMENT OFFICER; AND ESTABLISHING A RATE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that the new classification of Investment Officer meets those qualifications and definitions and should be designated as unclassified; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed this request on August 5, 1982, and has commented favorably to the Council upon the requested exemptions from the classified service of the classification; and

WHEREAS, a review of this classification indicates the nature and duties of the position are consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter Section 117(a)17; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that this position be established and exempted from the Classified Service pursuant to the Charter provisions; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to effectuate said creation and exemption; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission on August 5, 1982, the position of Investment Officer is hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 0-15750 (New Series) entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1982-83," be, and it is hereby amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to establish and reflect said position designation in the Unclassified Service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in Section 2 above, the position is hereby authorized and designated to be placed in Managerial Classification Range of Managerial C with Salary Range 7.7 and 7.8 attached thereto.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission on August 5, 1982, the position of Investment Officer, is hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-15750 (New Series) entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1982-83," be, and it is hereby amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to establish and reflect said position designation in the Unclassified Service.
