

ORDINANCE NUMBER O-15822 (New Series)

Adopted on September 27, 1982

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 6 OF THE
SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION
56.54 RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as
follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 6 of the San Diego
Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Section
56.54 to read as follows:

SEC. 56.54 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONSUMPTION
PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS

It shall be unlawful for any person without a permit
duly issued by the City Manager for a special event to
consume any alcoholic beverage, as defined in California
Business and Professions Code, Section 23004, upon any
public street, sidewalk, alley, plaza, or in any public
park within the following limits of the City of San Diego:

Starting at the intersection of Market Street and
Pacific Highway and proceeding northerly on Pacific
Highway to its intersection with Ash Street; then
easterly on Ash Street to its intersection with 11th
Avenue; then southerly on 11th Avenue to its
intersection with "A" Street; then easterly on "A"
Street to its intersection with 12th Avenue; then
southerly on 12th Avenue to its intersection with
Imperial Avenue; then westerly on Imperial Avenue to
the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad; then

westerly along the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad to its intersection with Union Street; then northerly on Union Street to its intersection with Market Street; and then westerly on Market Street to the point of beginning.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons consuming alcoholic beverages within the defined boundaries of a sidewalk cafe located on the public right-of-way. A sidewalk cafe is defined in Section 101.0550.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

The area described above shall include all sidewalks along the outer perimeter of such areas.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons consuming alcoholic beverages within the defined boundaries of a sidewalk cafe located on the public right-of-way during the hours such cafe is open for business. A sidewalk cafe is defined in Section 101.0550.
