AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 7 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0750 REGARDING OFF-PREMISES SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 7 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0750 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0750 TEMPORARY OFF-PREMISES SUBDIVISION DIRECTIONAL AND IDENTIFICATION SIGNS.

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose of this section to permit and regulate the use of temporary off-premises subdivision directional signs in order to provide, when necessary, adequate directions to and identification of new subdivisions.

It is the intent of this section to provide for temporary off-premises subdivision directional and identification signs that will conform to the criteria and standards contained in the approved guidelines in order to assure that the signs will not be detrimental to the character of the area in which they are installed.

B. PERMITTED USES

1. Temporary off-premises subdivision

directional and identification signs may be permitted by the Zoning Administrator by the issuance of a subdivision sign permit. The Zoning Administrator shall, if there appears to be a potential adverse impact due to the issuance of a permit, conduct a public hearing on the requested permit in accordance with the provisions set forth in Section 101.0502.
