AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 19, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1901, DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, BY DESIGNATING THE CITY COUNCIL AS APPOINTING AUTHORITY AND THE COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON RULES, LEGISLATION AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS AS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING DIRECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 19, Section 22.1901 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

## DIVISION 19

DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS

SEC. 22.1901 DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS

The Department of Intergovernmental Relations is a City department. The Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by a majority of the Council. The Director shall, under direction of the Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations, be responsible for planning, recommending, coordinating and administering a State and Federal legislative program for The City of San Diego. The department shall provide legislative coordination and liaison under direction of the Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations and, in consultation with City departments and other sources:

- (1) Develop for City Council approval City legislative programs for the State and Federal legislative sessions.
- (2) Represent the City before State and Federal legislative and administrative bodies.
- (3) Analyze and submit reports on State and Federal legislation affecting the City.
- (4) Maintain liaison with and assist the City's State and Federal legislative delegations in any matter of interest to the City.
- (5) Initiate and assist other City departments in identifying, seeking and receiving Federal and State grants and coordinate through legislative advocacy those grant efforts.
- (6) Represent city via appropriate endeavors in identifying, seeking and receiving endowments and related gifts of funds, buildings and facilities.
  - (7) Perform related work as directed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
