

RESOLUTION NO. R-255619Adopted on JAN 05 1982

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Ted Myrus	General Services	\$ 50	Mr. Myrus is an Equipment Repair Supervisor in the Equipment Division. He suggested that rotating lights be mounted on a pedestal on the tool box rather than directly on the roof of City vehicles. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Robert K. Hartnett	Fire	\$ 50	Mr. Hartnett is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that an additional guard rail be installed on the Seagrave aerial service trucks. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Ted Myrus	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Myrus is an Equipment Repair Supervisor in the Equipment Division. He suggested that a decal be used as an underhood service record on City vehicles. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Howard C. Wagner	Fire	\$ 25	Mr. Wagner is a Fire Captain. He suggested that water heaters in fire stations be wrapped with insulation blankets and venetian blinds be replaced with drapes for the purpose of energy conservation. While energy savings as a result of this suggestion cannot be calculated, the Committee felt an intangible award was justified.
Terrance L. O'Rourke	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. O'Rourke is a Fire Captain. He suggested that the dormitory and apparatus floor lights in Fire Station #10 be connected to separate switches. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
