CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 10-284-2

WHEREAS, COPLEY PRESS, INC., an Illinois corporation, dba
Union-Tribune Publishing Company, Owner, hereafter referred to
as "Permittee," filed an application for an amendment to
Conditional Use Permit No. 10-284-2 to erect and display wall
sign identification on four sides of the Union Tribune Building.
The site location is 350 Camino de la Reina and is more
particularly described as Lot 2, Golden Valley Unit No. 2, Map
6960, in the CO and FW Zones; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 1981, The Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of fact, approved an amendment to Conditional Use Permit No. 10-284-2 for two signs, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on December 14, 1981; and

WHEREAS, said Conditional Use Permit 10-284-2, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0507 of the San Diego Municipal Code, was set for public hearing on January 12, 1982, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Conditional Use Permit No. 10-284-2 amendment:

- 1. The General Plan designates this area for commercial recreation. The proposed Mission Valley plan designates this site for commercial office use. The recommended two signs would aid in identifying the building. The two signs would not adversely affect the General Plan and would not be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of persons residing or working in the area.
- 2. The proposed use will comply with all the relevant regulations of Section 101.0507 of the Municipal Code of The City of San Diego. Paragraph A5 grants the City Council authority, after recommendation by the Planning Commission, to approve newspaper publishing plants by a Conditional Use Permit, with appropriate conditions. The City Council believes that appropriate conditions exist to grant the amendment.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council does hereby grant to COPLEY PRESS, INC., an Illinois corporation, dba Union-Tribune Publishing Company, Owner and Permittee, Conditional Use Permit No. 10-284-2 amendment for two signs, in the form and with the terms and conditions as set forth in the permit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

 - b. The Conditional Use Permit is recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

If the signed permit is not received by the Planning Commission within 90 days of the City Council decision, the permit shall be void.
