

RESOLUTION NO. R-255734Adopted on JAN 26 1982

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Sharla A. Jensen Donna J. Evans	Police	\$ 455	Ms. Jensen and Ms. Evans are Senior Clerks in the Records Division. They suggested that the Records Division discontinue the processing of the "Dealer's Record of Sale of Revolver or Pistol" forms. This is expected to save \$3,024 in the first year in labor costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Thomas E. Trainor	Building Inspection	\$ 380	Mr. Trainor is an Electrical Inspection Supervisor. One year ago he earned an award for his suggestion to reduce the width of the center aisle on the third floor of COB. Following implementation of his suggestion, the Water Utilities Department relocated its public service counters to make better use of floor space. This action was a result of Mr. Trainor's suggestion, and yielded additional savings of \$1,260.
Carlos M. Inot	Police	\$ 250	Mr. Inot is a Detective in the Central Juvenile Division. He suggested that a form be developed for the recording of basic information on Police photographs. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Robert C. Frajman	General Services	\$ 100	Mr. Frajman is an Electrician in the Buildings Division. He suggested that fencing be installed around the control panels, wet well access and check valve pit at Pump Station #36A. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Davis E. Darnell	General Services	\$ 170	Mr. Darnell is a Sanitation Supervisor in the Streets Division. He suggested that the spray nozzles on the weed spraying trucks be redesigned. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
