WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego held a public hearing on October 22, 1981 to consider the proposed Mission Bay Coastal Access Study; and

WHEREAS, said Access Study was developed as the Coastal Access Component of the Local Coastal Program Land Use Plans for Mission Beach, Pacific Beach and Mission Bay Park with the goals of providing an access and transportation network to assure that maximum public access to the coast and public recreation areas is provided; and

WHEREAS, said Access Study has been developed to respond to the policies, goals and requirements of the California Coastal Act of 1976; and

WHEREAS, said Access Study will amend portions of the existing adopted Mission-Pacific Beach Community Plan and Mission Bay Park Master Plan for land and water use located in the Coastal Zone; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has also reviewed the Mission Bay Coastal Access Study and heard all public testimony; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that implementation of the recommendations of this study will have to compete with City-wide projects for limited City funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That this Council hereby adopts the Mission Bay Coastal


Access Study as an accurate statement of its policy and intent, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 255737 .

2. That the Planning Director is hereby authorized to submit the Mission Bay Coastal Access Study to the California Coastal Commission as part of the City's program to comply with the California Coastal Act of 1976.

3. That implementation of the recommendations of the Mission Bay Coastal Access Study will compete with City-wide projects for limited City funds.
