

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert B. Hamby	General Services	\$ 455	Mr. Hamby is an Equipment Trainer in the Equipment Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$250 for his suggestion to remove the fuel from City vehicles prior to sale. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$2,353. This is the remainder of his award.
John M. Cortez	Park & Recreation	\$ 415	Mr. Cortez is a Grounds Maintenance Worker III in the Central Division. He suggested that damaged sprinkler heads be converted for use as testing heads. This is expected to save \$2,790 in the first year in labor costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Russell I. Skillman	General Services	\$ 340	Mr. Skillman was a Senior Clerk in the Buildings Division at the time he submitted his suggestion. He suggested that the billing system for metered mail be simplified. The actual first year's savings as a result of this suggestion are \$3,389 in labor costs. This is a full award.
Albert L. Brown Jack Mead	Park & Recreation	\$ 320	Mr. Brown is a Utility Worker and Mr. Mead is an Equipment Technician in the Coastal Division. One year ago they earned a partial award of \$160 for their suggestion to construct a puller tool for removing seal plates on the Gorman Rupp pump. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,601. This is the remainder of their award.
Robert L. Spangler, Jr.	Fire	\$ 250	Mr. Spangler is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that manilla rope be removed from Fire apparatuses and replaced with static kernmantle, gold line rope. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
