<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Rolando B. Pritchard	Police	\$ 150	Mr. Pritchard was a Field Representative at the time he submitted his suggestion to implement a system for the return of lost or abandoned barricades and pylons. One year's experience resulted in the return of almost 300 barricades to City shops. The Committee initially approved a \$100 intangible award for the suggester's effort, and following receipt of additional information, felt it appropriate to approve this additional award.
Wanda N. Polk	General Services	\$ 105	Ms. Polk is an Auto Messenger in the Buildings Division. One year ago she earned a partial award of \$95 for her suggestion to combine two mail runs. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$668. This is the remainder of her award.
Joe A. Pirronello	Fire	\$ 100	Mr. Pirronello is a Fire Captain. He developed an information chart to be used with the N.F.I.R.S. reporting system. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
John E. Chaffin	Water Utilities	\$ 75	Mr. Chaffin is an Assistant Chemist in the Systems Division. He suggested that the filter supports for the aquaculture research project be constructed from p.v.c. pipe rather than redwood. This is expected to save \$243 in the first year in labor and material costs.
Linda M. King	General Services	\$ 65	Ms. King was an Auto Messenger in the Buildings Division. She suggested that mail runs to outlying stations be reduced to twice weekly. This suggestion has saved \$210 in the first year in labor and equipment costs.
