BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for

CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTHCREST PARK & RECREATION CENTER BALLFIELD AND CHANNEL FENCING,

HOLLYWOOD PARK FENCING AND COLINA DEL SOL PARK BOCCI COURT FENCING, San Diego, California

filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego, California, on FEB 24 '82, and bearing official Document No. R-00292, be, and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council has ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said specifications is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts therein mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent of the City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for

CONSTRUCTION OF SOUTHCREST PARK & RECREATION CENTER BALLFIELD AND CHANNEL FENCING,


HOLLYWOOD PARK FENCING AND COLINA DEL SOL PARK BOCCI COURT FENCING.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to add CIP No. 29-438, HOLLYWOOD PARK FENCING, and CIP No. 29-439, COLINA DEL SOL BOCCI COURT FENCING, into the FY 1982 Capital Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00 from PSD Fund 15630 to CIP No. 29-438, HOLLYWOOD PARK FENCING; and to transfer an amount not to exceed \$2,312.00 from PSD Fund 11615 and \$688.00 from PSD Fund 11611 to CIP No. 29-439, COLINA DEL SOL BOCCI COURT FENCING.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of \$42,500.00 from CIP No. 23-781, SOUTHCREST COMMUNITY PARK IMPROVEMENTS; \$6,000.00 from CIP No. 29-438, HOLLYWOOD PARK FENCING; and \$3,000.00 from CIP No. 29-439, COLINA DEL SOL BOCCI COURT FENCING of the City of San Diego is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, and authorizing the Auditor and Comptroller upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any to the appropriate reserves.


