A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 8, 1982 WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 29, 1981 the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-255115 declaring its intention to submit to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego Ordinance No. O-15554 (New Series) for approval or rejection; and

WHEREAS, On March 9, 1982 the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O- 15674 (New Series) calling a special municipal election to be held in the City on June 8, 1982 for the purpose of submitting said ordinance to the qualified voters for their approval or rejection; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide primary election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on June 8, 1982 with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego Ordinance No. O-15554 (New Series) for approval or rejection.

2. The exact form of the proposition to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as it is to appear on the ballot is as follows:

Shall Ordinance No. O-15554 (New Series), adopted by the Council of The City of San Diego, be approved so as to amend the City Employees' Retirement System by establishing the 1981 Pension System for all employees hired on and after September 4, 1981?	NO	

The proposition shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide primary election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding

of a consolidated election.

5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
