

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 256000

Adopted on MAR 15 1982

WHEREAS, Senate Bill S.1701, entitled the "Missing Children Act" was introduced in Congress by Senator Paula Hawkins (R-Florida); and

WHEREAS, S.1701 would provide a national clearinghouse for identification of missing children, allow [the names of] all missing children to be listed in a national crime information center, provide parental access to a computer network, and assist in identification of deceased children, runaways, and victims of parental kidnapping; and

WHEREAS, S.1701 would require the Attorney General to acquire and preserve any information which would assist in the identification of any deceased person who has not been identified within fifteen days after discovery of the body; and

WHEREAS, S.1701 would require the Attorney General to collect and preserve from federal, state and local officials and from parents or relatives of a child, information which could assist in the location of a missing person who meets the following criteria:


1. Is under physical or mental disability;
2. Is in the company of another person under circumstances indicating a danger to the victim;
3. Disappears involuntarily;

4. Is unemancipated by the laws of the home state. Unemancipated means the person has not attained the age of majority which would include all missing children; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of The City of San Diego that this Council does hereby declare its support of Senate Bill S.1701, entitled "Missing Children Act" and urges its passage by the Congress of the United States.
