WHEREAS, City employees are encouraged to use alternative transportation methods, such as carpooling, vanpooling, and bicycling as a component of the City's air quality and energy programs; and

WHEREAS, employees who bicycle to work have requested secure storage facilities for their bicycles; and

WHEREAS, a limited number of bicycle lockers and racks have been acquired and placed on the Parkade terrace level and at the Police Department location on Market Street; and

WHEREAS, all of the existing lockers are filled and twenty (20) persons are on a waiting list for a locker space; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate and recommended that an additional twenty-four (24) bicycle lockers and sixteen (16) bicycle racks be purchased in order to provide adequate secure storage facilities and further encourage employees to bicycle to work; and

WHEREAS, the additional storage facilities would be placed in both the Concourse area and at the Police Station; and

WHEREAS, the Public Services and Safety Committee has reviewed this request during discussions on the City's Energy/Transportation Program at which time it was estimated that the cost would be \$5,680; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to purchase

twenty-four (24) bicycle lockers and sixteen (16) bicycle racks for placement in the Community Concourse area and Police Station at Market Street for use by City employees who ride bicycles to work as an alternative means of transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to expend a sum, not to exceed \$5,680 from the General Fund 100, Unallocated Reserve (605) for the above described purchase of bicycle lockers and racks.
