WHEREAS, the Nicholson Act was written by the first Congress of the United States and enacted in 1793; and

WHEREAS, the Nicholson Act forbids any foreign flag vessel from off-loading anywhere in the United States; and

WHEREAS, this Act is one of the few protections the U. S. fishing fleet has; and

WHEREAS, Bumble Bee Cannery, a division of Castle & Cooke, is requesting an amendment to the Nicholson Act, or a separate treaty, to allow Japan to off-load fish in Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, Bumble Bee is the only cannery in Hawaii and, therefore, would solely benefit from this amendment or separate treaty; and

WHEREAS, this amendment or separate treaty would encourage or prompt other such amendments or treaties; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego does hereby urge that the Congress of the United States deny any amendment or separate treaty to allow any foreign-flag vessel to off-load fish anywhere in the United States.
