

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- **256587**

Adopted on JUN 15 1982

WHEREAS, Senate Resolution (SR) 317 was introduced in the U. S. Congress by Senator Howard Cannon (D-Nev.) on February 10, 1982; and

WHEREAS, said resolution urges the Interstate Commerce Commission to place a moratorium on new grants of authority to foreign trucking companies to operate in the United States; and

WHEREAS, this measure is currently pending in the Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee with no hearing date yet scheduled; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1404 was introduced in the California Legislature by Senator Jim Ellis on February 1, 1982; and

WHEREAS, as amended in April, SB 1404 would require foreign truckers operating in California to abide by the same rules, codes, directives, regulations and statutes that California trucking companies are mandated by law to operate under; and

WHEREAS, recently, this bill was advanced to the Senate floor avoiding a Finance Committee hearing based on a determination that there was not sufficient monies involved to be heard by a fiscal committee; and

WHEREAS, Senator Ellis' office expects a full floor discussion in the near future and is anticipating opposition;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
that this Council, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego,
hereby expresses and declares its support of U. S. Senate
Resolution 317 and California Senate Bill 1404.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be, and he is
hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the San
Diego area congressional members in Congress and the San Diego
area State legislative members in Sacramento.
