WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Garland F. Simpson	Fire	\$ 75	Mr. Simpson is a Fire Fighter. He suggested that Fire Fighters no longer be required to ride on the back of the combination brush/structure rigs as a safety precaution. This suggestion led to the removal of the bars at the back of the rigs which were considered to be hazardous. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Sylvia Taylor	Risk Management	\$ 70	Ms. Taylor is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that payment instructions be included on the Claims Recovery contact letters. This is expected to save \$235 in the first year in labor costs.
Robert C. Nightingale	Planning	\$ 55	Mr. Nightingale is a Zoning Representative in the Zoning Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$60 for his suggestion to eliminate hillside permit numbers on zoning maps. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,161. This is the remainder of his award.
Diane P. Gould	Financial Management	\$ 40	Ms. Gould is a Principal Clerk in the REGY Division. She suggested that employees use the trolley for trips between the REGY office and the City Concourse. This is expected to save \$129 in the first year in mileage payments and parking costs.
Mary L. Griffin	General Services	\$ 35	Ms. Griffin is an Intermediate Typist in the Streets Division. She suggested that route slips be placed in numerical order by the responding division. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
