WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by City Council resolution where the portion of street to be vacated consists of excess width right-of-way; where for a period of five consecutive years the street to be vacated has been impassable for vehicular travel and during such period no public money has been expended for maintenance; and where a street has been superseded by relocation; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of a portion of Ingulf Street between Hartford Street and the alley to the east, adjacent to Lot 1, Block 118; the alley between Ingulf and Huxley Streets, adjacent to Lots 1-28 in Block 117; Huxley Street between the alley in Block 117 and the center line of Illion Street; a portion of Illion Street adjacent to Lots 15-28, Block 117; and Ingulf Street between the center line of the alley, Block 118, and the east line of Illion Street, all of Morena Map 809, within and adjacent to the proposed CAMELOT TRAILS SUBDIVISION (TM 79-373) boundaries to facilitate development of their properties; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the streets to be vacated will continue to have access; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- That a portion of Illion, Ingulf, and Huxley Streets and the alley in Block 117 of Morena, Map 809, all within or adjacent to the Camelot Trails Subdivision (TM 79-373) boundaries, as more particularly shown on Drawing Nos. 15404-1-B and 15404-2-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. RR- 256674-2 and RRis by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawings, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the Camelot Trails Subdivision Map has been approved by Council action. In the event that the above condition cannot be met, this resolution shall become void and of no further effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the approval of the aforementioned subdivision map, and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
