## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 256701

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SHELTER ISLAND, AIRPORT, AND EMBARCADERO STREET LIGHTING AREAS AND TO ANNEX SAID AREAS INTO THE SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 65.0201, et seq. of the San Diego Municipal Code and Sections 22500, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code, The City of San Diego proposed the formation of the SHELTER ISLAND, AIRPORT, AND EMBARCADERO STREET LIGHTING AREAS and the annexation of the district into the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Report, including the maps incorporated therein, as required by Section 65.0217(3) of the San Diego Municipal Code has been considered and approved and filed with the City Clerk as Document No. 1256700; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity require and it is the intention of this Council to order the formation and establishment of the maintenance areas pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975 (commencing with Sections 65.0201, et seq. of the San Diego Municipal Code) for the maintenance of public facilities within the boundaries of the areas to be known as the SHELTER ISLAND,

AIRPORT, AND EMBARCADERO STREET LIGHTING AREAS. The maintenance shall include, but is not limited to the supplying of energy to streetlights, replacement of lamps and glassware, and periodic cleaning and painting of standards.

- 2. The subject property to be maintained shall be designated as such in the above referenced Engineer's Report (including the maps therein) on file in the office of the City Clerk, which report provides a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district and any zones therein, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the district.
- 3. The contemplated maintenance is, in the opinion of the Council, of more than local, ordinary public benefit, and the expenses of such maintenance should be made chargeable upon the areas herein described, and the Council does declare said areas to be the areas benefited by the maintenance.
  - 4. The proposed areas are generally described as follows:

The abutting property and rights-of-way of
Shelter Island Drive southeasterly of Shafter Street;
Harbor Drive from Scott Street to Hawthorn Street
including Laurel Street westerly of Pacific Highway;
and Harbor Drive from Hawthorn Street to 32nd Street
including Broadway westerly of Pacific Highway, and
Pacific Highway from Broadway southerly to Harbor
Drive; as shown on the map on file in the office of
the City Clerk as Document No. 763517, and also
the maps for the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance
District No. 1.

- 5. It is proposed that the maintenance shall be performed beginning July 1, 1982.
- 6. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 27, 1982 at

  2:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City

  Administration Building, 202 "C" Street, in the City of San

  Diego, California, are the day, hour and place for the hearing

  when and where any and all persons having any objection or

  protest to the proposed maintenance or to the extent of the

  areas to be assessed, may appear and show cause why the proposed

  maintenance should not be carried out in accordance with this

  resolution of intention; failure to make objections at this time

  shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall

  operate as a bar for any and all claims.

Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested sufficient to identify the same and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk at a time not later than the hour set for the hearing.

- 7. The assessments, if any, will be levied pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975.
- 8. That the City Clerk is directed to cause this resolution or a notice thereof to be published once at least fifteen (15) days before the date of the hearing in the City Official Newspaper.
- 9. The City Clerk is directed to mail copies of this resolution or notices thereof, postage prepaid, to all persons owning real property proposed to be assessed whose names and addresses appear on the last equalized County assessment roll.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of The City of San Diego to further consider the annexation of the SHELTER ISLAND, AIRPORT, AND EMBARCADERO STREET LIGHTING AREAS into the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1, and to declare such annexation if such annexation is deemed appropriate at the conclusion of the public hearing.
