BACKGROUND

The City Council is concerned with the increasing cost of City support of special events examples of which are marathons, walkathons, golf tournaments and hydroplane races, concerts and street events. The Council notes that City support of special events, be it police traffic service, police patrol or other support, is not specially budgeted and is provided through reductions in the level of service for budgeted programs. The Council also realizes that special events are a major part of that special lifestyle that makes the City of San Diego unique.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. "SPECIAL EVENT" means any set of activities conducted by an individual or an assembly of persons under responsible direction and control for the primary purpose of enhancing individual or collective use or benefit, and which involves the use of public facilities and possible provision of City services ancillary thereto. Examples of Special Events include but are not limited to:
 - (a) Parades, as defined in Municipal Code Section 22.0207.
 - (b) Mass participation sports such as running marathons and "Over the Line" tournaments.
 - (c) Spectator sports including football, basketball, baseball games, professional golf tournaments, hydroplane races, horse races.
 - (d) Circuses, fairs and rodeos.
 - (e) Music concerts and other community cultural events.
 - (f) Film making activities.
 - (g) Commercial and non-profit conventions.
 - (h) Special street markets and shopping events.
 - (i) Community or neighborhood block parties and street dances.
 - (j) San Diego Stadium and Sports Arena activities.
 - (k) Public speaker events.
- "CITY SUPPORT" means any City services required to maintain minimal interfenence and inconvenience to the general public resulting from a Special Event. City support includes but is not limited to:
 - (a) Police services.
 - (b) Sanitation and cleanup.
 - (c) Maintaining access for emergency vehicles and provision of medical care. City support does not enclude internal security, crowd control and other services considered the responsibility of the Special Event Sponsor.
- 3. "PUBLIC FACILITY" means any property, building, or public access (street, beach, park, sports arena, theater, etc.) that lies within the City and which is owned or operated for public benefit or usage.

- 4. "SPONSOR" means any person, group, or corporation assuming responsibility for planning, promoting, and carrying out a Special Event.
- 5. "CITY MANAGER" means the City Manager or assigned representative.

PURPOSE

It is the purpose of this policy to provide guidelines, for the support of special events, consistent with the least possible disruption to normal City services.

POLICY

- 1. It is the policy of the City Council that City support to special events, a part of the uniqueness of San Diego, will be provided whenever reasonably possible.
- 2. It is the policy of the City Council that no person or persons shall organize, produce, direct, conduct, manage, institute or carry out any special event without first obtaining a special events permit from the City Manager.
- 3. It is the policy of the City Council that no person shall promote, advertise, encourage or solicit attendance or otherwise participate in any way in a special event for which no permit has been issued or for which such permit has been suspended or revoked.
- 4. It is the policy of the City Council that the City Manager and the special event sponsor(s) will ensure that the setup, operation, control, and cleanup related to a special event will be handled with a minimum of City support consistent with the public safety.
- 5. It is the policy of the City Council that volunteer and private resources will be used in lieu of City support for special events wherever possible.
- 6. It is the policy of the City Council that the City Manager may, in the interest of public safety or to minimize City support, specify to the sponsor certain guidelines for the conduct of a special event to include, but not be limited to, time, location, emergency equipment, and support personnel.
