RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 8, 1982, ON A REFERENDUM OF THE PEOPLE OF SAN DIEGO FOR APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 0-15554 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 10, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0105 AND BY AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, BY ADDING A NEW DIVISION 11, SECTIONS 24.1100 THROUGH 24.1114 THERETO, ALL RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM."

WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinance No. O-15674 (New Series) adopted March 9, 1982, called a special municipal election to be held in the City on June 8, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the special municipal election was held on June 8, 1982 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City Ordinance No. O-15554 (New Series), as follows:

## PROPOSITION A:

APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 0-15554 (NEW SERIES).

Shall Ordinance No. O-15554 (New Series), adopted by the Council of The City of San Diego, be approved so as to amend the City Employees' Retirement System by establishing the 1981 Pension System for all employees hired on and after September 4, 1981?

; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the special municipal election, including absentee votes cast, as certified to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the special municipal election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

- 1. The whole number of votes cast in the City, including absentee votes, is 205,515.
- 2. The number of votes, including absentee votes, cast for and against Proposition A and the total number of votes cast upon the proposition, including absentee votes, is as follows:
