RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 256864 Adopted on JUL 26 1982

WHEREAS, the City Council of The City of San Diego ("Council") has from time to time appropriated funds for and authorized the transfer of those funds to the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego ("Agency") for the purpose of implementing past and present redevelopment projects of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Council anticipates that it will in the future appropriate funds for and authorize the transfer of those funds to the Agency for the purpose of implementing present and future redevelopment projects of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has recorded and will record such transfers of funds as advances from The City of San Diego ("City") to the Agency, such advances constituting a debt of the Agency to the City to be repaid from tax increment revenues or other revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted Resolution No. 254515 dated June 23, 1981, imposing an interest charge at a rate of ten percent (10%) on outstanding debt of the Redevelopment Agency; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Resolution No. 254515 dated June 23, 1981, be amended as follows:

- 1. That commencing July 1, 1982, all debt of the Agency to the City shall be subject to an annual interest charge of the maximum rate permitted by law.
- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to compute and accrue interest on the outstanding balance of the Agency debt to the City.
- 3. That in the event the Agency desires to issue bonds, notes, or other instruments of indebtedness of the Agency to carry out the Agency's redevelopment projects, then any indebtedness of the Agency to the City, including any interest accrued thereon, shall be deemed not to be a first pledge of tax increment allocations received by the Agency pursuant to Health and Safety Code, Section 33670; and any indebtedness of the Agency to the City, including any interest accrued thereon, shall be subordinate to any pledge of tax increments to bondholders or the holders of other such instruments of indebtedness.
