A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH RESPECT TO AN INITIATIVE MEASURE TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON NOVEMBER 2, 1982, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, THE City Clerk has certified to the City Council that an initiative petition to adopt an ordinance relating to criteria for a Paramedic Transport System has a sufficient number of signatures to qualify the initiative for the ballot under Section 23 of the City Charter and Section 27.2503 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to submit the aforementioned initiative to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego at a special municipal election to be held in the City on November 2, 1982; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide general election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the statewide general election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 2, 1982, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of voting on the proposed ordinance which has qualified for the ballot by initiative petition as aforesaid.

2. The exact form of the proposition to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as it is to appear on the ballot is as follows:

<p>PROPOSITION ____ . CITY OF SAN DIEGO INITIATIVE MEASURE.</p> <p>Shall the people of the City of San Diego ordain that the City will adopt a Paramedic Transport System meeting the following criteria:</p> <p>A. All Paramedics will be assigned to Paramedic Transport ambulances meeting the requirements for Paramedic ambulances set by State law. Paramedics will respond to all medical emergencies in these Paramedic ambulances. Paramedics will transport all patients requiring Paramedic care to an emergency medical facility in these Paramedic ambulances, in accordance with State law and San Diego County Paramedic protocols.</p> <p>B. The system adopted may use public resources only, a combination of public and private resources or private resources only.</p>	<p>YES</p>

The proposition shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.

5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
