Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law provides a procedure
for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements
by City Council resolution where the street or highway has been
superseded by relocation; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of a portion of Carroll Canyon Road in the southwest 1/4 of Section 3 and Carroll Road in the northwest 1/4 of Section 10, both in T15S, R3W, SBM, within the proposed El Camino Industrial Park Subdivision (TM 82-0073) boundaries, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that a portion of Carroll Canyon Road and Carroll Road, all within the El Camino Industrial Park Subdivision (TM 82-0073) boundaries, as more particularly shown on Drawings No. 15697-B and No. 15698-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 257052-/ and Document No. RR- 257052-2 which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part

hereof, be and the same are hereby ordered vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the El Camino Industrial Park subdivision map has been approved by Council action. In the event that the above conditions cannot be met, this resolution shall become void and of no further effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the approval of the aforementioned subdivision map, and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
