RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 2571.43 Adopted on SEP 14 1982

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the Streets and Highways
Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by
City Council resolution where for a period of five consecutive
years the streets to be vacated have been impassable for
vehicular travel and during such period no public money has been
expended for maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of 23rd Street between "A" Street and Russ Boulevard, and "A" Street between 23rd and 24th Streets, adjacent to Blocks A, B and 9 of Culver and Taggart's Addition, Map 249, all within or adjacent to the Vista de Oro Subdivision boundary, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, those streets to be vacated have been impassable for five consecutive years and no public money has been expended for maintenance; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the streets to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that 23rd Street between "A" Street and Russ Boulevard, and "A"

Street between 23rd and 24th Streets adjacent to Blocks A, B and 9 of Culver and Taggart's Addition, Map 249, all within or adjacent to the Vista de Oro Subdivision boundary, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15659-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 25743-/, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement and priviledge of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to nonmotor vehicular and general utilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along and across the hereinafter described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of an encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees or the installation of privately owned pipelines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other structures, equipment and fixtures for the transportation or distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over and across the above described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the easements reserved herein are in, under, over, upon, along and across 23rd Street between "A" Street and Russ Boulevard, and "A" Street between 23rd and 24th Streets adjacent to Blocks A, B and 9, of Culver and Taggart's Addition, Map 249, all within or adjacent to the Vista de Oro Subdivision boundary vacated by this document and as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15659-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall not become effective unless and until the Vista de Oro Subdivision Map (TM 02-142), subdividing the land adjacent to the right-of-way, has been approved by Council action. In the event that the above condition cannot be met, this resolution shall become void and of no further effect.


